Dear Chair Eaken and SFMTA Board Directors,

San Francisco Transit Riders (SFTR) urges you to approve the M Oceanview Transit and Safety Project, which will improve safety and bring significant speed, reliability, and accessibility improvements to the M Oceanview Muni Metro line, which serves several Equity Strategy neighborhoods.

The project features common-sense improvements for the M Line which will benefit the line's 18,000 daily riders by getting trains out of traffic, improving accessibility for riders with wheelchairs or strollers, and adding much-needed pedestrian safety improvements.

We commend project staff's commitment to working with the community to find a solution that addresses their concerns while still providing the crucial transit and safety improvements that riders need and deserve, while maintaining uniform stop spacing. We hope we can continue to work with the SFMTA on future improvements along this corridor to further speed up the M line and improve frequency and accessibility at all Muni Metro stops.
